### **RE: TRIP TO WESTMINSTER - TUESDAY 6TH JUNE 2023**

In connection with Year 5's curriculum study of citizenship this term, we are supporting a campaign by UCL students (with whom your children have recently had workshops) and CitizensUK to demand a change in the law to ensure children from NRPF families receive child benefit.

Your child has been chosen to take part in a trip to London on Tuesday 6th June. We will be travelling by train to Westminster, where we will meet with other schools and organisations to form part of an activity to support all children getting child benefit.
