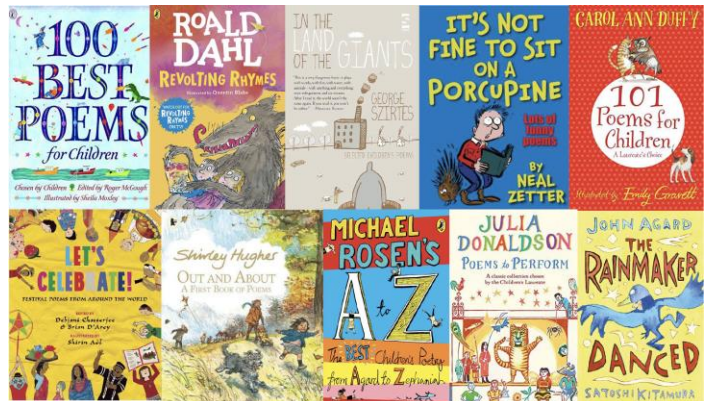

Poetry Week: Monday 26th April – Friday 30th April 2021

Next week, we will be celebrating and enjoying another 'Book Week', our focus this year is on **Poetry**. The children will be spending time engaging in a number of exciting activities throughout the week. This includes, making their own poetry anthology, and listening to and performing a range of poetry. Our staff are looking forward to taking part in a teacher reading poetry swap. We have also invited a poet called Adisa the Verbaliser who will be performing to the children in KS2. The aim of the week is to encourage and promote a love of poetry and to continue to inspire our children to read a wide range of books. We would love for the children to bring in a copy of their favourite poems or nursery rhymes to share with their class.

On **Friday 30th April**, we invite the children and staff to **dress up** as their favourite or well-known character from a poem or nursery rhyme that they know and pay **£1.00**. Think of some classic nursery rhymes such as; The Owl and the Pussy Cat, Mary had a Little Lamb, Old Mother Hubbard or some modern classic poems such as; Gran (from Gran Can You Rap), the boy from Michael Rosen's 'Chocolate Cake'.
