Week 1	<p>Phonics Click here to watch today's phonics video. Now practise your spelling.</p> <p>Reading. Read for 10 minutes. Listen to 'Oi, Frog!' Can you hear some rhyming words?</p>  <p>Writing .Watch the video about rhyme. Now have a go at spotting rhyming words in 'Rhyming Words 1' and 'Rhyming Words 2'. Now help Big Bird find words that rhyme with beep.</p> <p>Maths Count in 3s using this song to help you. Today let's let's make equal groups by sharing. Click here to watch the video. Now complete the sheet 'Monday Maths'.</p> <p>RE Today we are going to answer the question 'How do Muslims show commitment to God during Ramadan?' Watch this video to learn about Ramadan. Go to Purple Mash and complete your 2do by writing a diary of a person fasting in Ramadan. What can you do? What can't you do? Which things are hard? How do you feel? Did you hear any more rhyming words?</p>  <p>Writing Read the Poem 'What is pink?' Underline or write down all the words that you can find which rhyme. What do you notice about these words? Where are they in the poem? Make a list of any other words you can think of to rhyme with them e.g. green, between, mean, clean. Which can you make the longest rhyming string with? An online rhyming dictionary could help you.</p> <p>Maths Count in 3s using this song to help you. Let's build on what we learned yesterday. Click here and have a go at the sheet 'Tuesday Maths'.</p> <p>PE Let's get moving with Joe Wickes!</p> <p>RE Read through 'RE Tuesday PowerPoint' to learn about Hajj. Go to purple mash and complete your 2do by drawing a picture of your special place and writing some sentences telling me where it is, what it's like and why it's special. Read for 10 minutes. Listen to the story, 'Oi Duck Billed Platypus!'. Some words are hard to rhyme! What rhymes with your name? What would you have to sit on?</p>  <p>Writing Read the Poem 'What is pink?' Answer the questions below: List all the colours mentioned in the poem. - Which fruits are described in the poem? - Which flowers are described in the poem? - Which is your favourite description? What do you like about it?</p> <p>Maths Count in 3s using this song to help you. Now, we'll learn about grouping. Watch the video here. Now complete the sheet 'Wednesday Maths'.</p> <p>Music Work through the activities and questions on 'Music Wednesday'. Complete the sheet 'Music Wednesday Sheet'. It's by Julia Donaldson – can you remember any of her other rhyming stories?</p>  <p>Writing Re-read the poem and highlight any words you are unsure of e.g. brink, violet, rich, ripe, mellow, barley. You could use an online children's dictionary to look these words up. Then draw pictures to match each description in the poem. Can you put them all together to make one picture?</p> <p>Maths Count in 3s using this song to help you. Time to continue with grouping. Watch the video here. 'Thursday Maths'.</p> <p>PE Let's try some yoga today.</p> <p>Music Work through the activities in 'Thursday Music'. Use the 'Thursday Music Sheet' to help you. If you are not able to use these resources, see if you can make your own musical instrument at home from recycled materials.
