Wednesday School Closures To Continue

I hope that you and your families remain safe and well. Please can I thank you for the wonderful support that the school has received from our parents since we reopened the school to all children in September. It has been a real challenge but together we have kept the children's safety, wellbeing and education at the heart of all the choices we have made.

As you will be aware, rates of Covid-19 are rising, both in London and Nationally. I have valued all of the feedback we have received from parents regarding our response to Covid-19. Closing the school on Wednesdays for a **Risk Assessment Review and Deep Clean** has enabled us to continually review and improve our procedures, as well as enabling additional cleaning.

I have therefore decided that for the remainder of the Autumn term, we will continue to close the school to all pupils every Wednesday. There will be two exceptions:

- We will continue to invite our youngest learners in to school from Nursery and Reception, so that these children can continue to settle into school routines
- In addition, we will also be able to invite our **Year 6** children into school for focused group teaching in preparation for their SATS and their transition to Secondary school
