# Dear Parents/Carers,

It has been wonderful to welcome you and your children to St Mary's and to the beginning of their school journey. The children have settled really well into their new class. They have engaged well with activities, both in the classroom and outside in the playground.

# **Topic**

Each half term we choose a topic to extend the children's knowledge of the outside world. This half term we are looking at all those people with jobs that involve looking after our community. We hope to have visits from local community members such as the Father Steve from St Mary's Church and the Fire Service. If you work in a caring profession, we would love you to come and talk to the class, if you have half an hour to spare.



#### Read, Write Inc

Reception class have been introduced to our systematic program of phonics called Read, Write Inc. Each day they learn to read and write a new sound. Soon they will be starting 'word time', where they learn to blend sounds to read simple words. **Don't forget, we will be having a 'Meet the Teacher' in school for all Reception parents on Thursday 28**<sup>th</sup> **September after school at 3:00PM**. At the meeting, I will be explaining how this phonics system teaches children to become successful readers and writers. I will also be looking at ways you can support your child's literacy skills at home.

Home Learning will be set from the end of September. It will be handed out on Friday and should be completed by Tuesday. There is a clear expectation that every child fully completes their Home Learning every week and we will be keeping a record and contacting parents where this is not the case.

### Reading

It is vital that your child is read to every day. Please complete their reading journal and ensure that they bring it into school. Your child will be given books, which we will aim to change on a weekly basis. If you have any concerns or would like some support with this, then please contact the school.
