

Bible story links (numbers in brackets are page numbers from the Lion Bible for children):

1. Moses and the Ten Commandments (203 - 205) - In the Old Testament, God provides Moses (who is leading the Israelites on their journey to escape from Egypt to the promised land) with a set of commandments to follow. We can reflect on why different communities use rules to show respect to everyone and why we should follow rules. We can plan our own commandments to ensure that we respect ourselves, other people, property, our school and everyone's right to learn.
2. Ruth and Naomi (117 - 119) - Ruth shows respect to her mother-in-law by following her on a journey to a new place. She shows respect for Naomi's people and beliefs. Ruth also shows respect for hard work as she works in the fields as harvest.
3. Solomon builds a temple to God in Jerusalem (154)
4. Jesus tells the parable of the builders on the rocks and sand (247). This well-known story illustrates the importance of building one's life on the teachings and examples of Jesus. We can reflect on the 'Rock' that our school vision and values provide for our school community and how we can build on these solid foundations.
5. Jesus at the temple (Matthew 21: 12-16) (277 - 278) - Jesus is indignant at the lack of respect that is being shown in the temple - what should be a house of prayer and healing is being turned into a space for businesses to make money.
6. Ephesians 6:1-4 Respect your parents.
