

## Bible quotes about Responsibility:

Genesis 1:27 'God said to human beings, 'Fill the earth with people and look after it. Care for all that I have made'.'

1 Peter 2:16 'Live as people who are free, not using your freedom as a cover-up for wrong choices, but living as servants of God.'

Proverbs 6:6-8 'Lazy people should learn a lesson from the way ants live. They have no leader, chief, or ruler but they store up their food during the summer, getting ready for winter.'

Psalms 8:6-8 'You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet: all flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild, the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.' *(this Bible quote is about how God gives responsibility to people to care for everything that he has created)*

Acts 13: 1-3 'Now in the church at Antioch there were prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen and Saul. While they were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." So after they had fasted and prayed, they placed their hands on them and sent them off.'

Acts 14:23 'Paul and Barnabas appointed elders in every church. With prayer and fasting, they turned the elders over to the care of the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.'

Acts 14:26-27 'They sailed back to Antioch, where they had been committed to the grace of God for the work they had now completed. On arriving there, they gathered the church together and reported all that God had done through them and how he had opened a door of faith to the Gentiles.' *(these Bible quotes from Acts are about missionaries being given responsibility to spread God's word, the third quote confirms that they have returned after a successful mission)*

Joshua 1:16 'Then the people answered Joshua, "We will do whatever you command us to do. We will go wherever you tell us to go. We will obey whatever you say, just as we obeyed Moses. We only ask that the Lord your God be with you just as he was with Moses.'

Matthew 12:37 'For by your words you will be justified.'

Galatians 6:2-5 'Help each other with your troubles. When you do this, you truly obey the law of Christ. If anyone thinks that he is important when he is not really important, he is only fooling himself. He should not compare himself with others. Each person should judge his own actions. Then he can be proud for what he himself has done. Each person must be responsible for himself.'

Galatians 6:5 'For each will have to bear his own load.'

Romans 12:6-8 'Having gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, let us use them: if prophecy, in proportion to our faith; if service, in our serving; the one who teaches, in his teaching; the one who exhorts, in his exhortation; the one who contributes, in generosity; the one who leads, with zeal; the one who does acts of mercy, with cheerfulness.'

2 Timothy 1:7 'For God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.'
