PE KIT AND UNIFORM REMINDERS

Children in Years 3,4,5 and 6 will wear their Uniform to school and change into their PE kit before their PE lessons. Children in Years 1 and 2 will continue to wear their PE kit to school for the whole day. The days for PE in 2022 / 2023 will be:

- Tuesday – Year 1 and Year 2
- Thursday – Year 3 and Year 4
- Friday – Year 5 and Year 6



PE Kit is **plain black shorts / jogging bottoms and a plain white T-shirt**. Children should wear **plain black trainers**. In cooler weather, children should wear their School Jumper. No clothing or footwear with logos or labels on will be allowed.

Please can we remind you of our School Uniform Policy, a copy of which is attached to this email. You can also follow this link to our school website: <https://st-marys.lewisham.sch.uk/school-uniform.html>. In particular, please can we remind you that:

- Jewellery is not allowed in school – earrings, necklaces and rings should not be worn as a matter of health and safety. If a child has pierced ears, plain studs are allowed.
- Shoes should be black and of a plain design.
- Hair should not be dyed unnatural colours.

- Apart from the School Jumper and optional blazer and tie, all other standard items of uniform can be purchased from any High Street store or Supermarket.
- Purchasing and wearing the School Blazer and School Tie is completely optional.
